

Stamp-making with Blu Tack and Erasers Material List

Blu Tack stamp

- Blu tack
- Greaseproof paper to roll blu tack out on.
- Small rolling pin or jar – something to roll your blu tack flat)
- Found items to imprint into the blu tack, such as woodblock stamps/ circular lids/ small toys/ shaped objects, or we can draw into it using a pencil/ end of paintbrush etc) – it could be as simple as your finger!
- Paper or cards to print onto
- ink pad or paint and small sponge

Making a stamp from an eraser

- An eraser – new or used is fine. More than one if you want to try more than one design
- A craft knife, although if you have lino tools, these will make things easier.
- Pencil
- Tracing paper (depending on how complex your design is)
- Paper
- Fine point sharpie (for colouring in the dark areas)
- Ink block/ stamp pad
- Paper/ cards to print onto
